

## **Galusha Farm Boarding Herd Deworming Policy, Procedure & Schedule**

(For self-administered de-wormer at Galusha Farm. Applies to every horse, pony, or donkey.)

1. The Galusha Farm Barn Manager will purchase the de-wormer recommended by our vet, supplied by FarmVet (where we have sales taxes removed).
2. The Galusha Farm Barn Manager will notify boarders/lessors, by group text, of the cost and the date that it is to be administered based on the below schedule. (within a 3-day window).
3. After the de-wormer is administered, boarders shall reimburse the barn manager directly within a week.
4. Boarders and Leasors shall administer the de-wormer themselves to their horse, pony, or donkey.
  - a. To show compliance, clearly write the name of the horse and the date administered on the box and email or text the photo to the barn manager.
5. The barn manager will keep a tracking spreadsheet to verify compliance and reimbursement.
6. If a boarder or lessor is unable to administer the de-wormer paste within the time frame (ex, out of town, sick, etc.), the barn manager must be notified, and the de-wormer medication will be administered by the barn manager.
  - a. There will be a \$10 fee for this service.
7. All new horses, ponies, or donkeys boarded at Galusha Farm should be dewormed, with proof of compliance outlined above, before arrival.
8. The Galusha Farm worming schedule shall be overlaid on the new horses' schedule and must be equal to or more stringent than our policy of de-wormer type and time frame (approximately every 3 months, equalling 4 x a year)
9. Care and training must be taken so that all of the de-wormer gets into the horse's stomach and not dropped on the ground during or just after it is administered, otherwise the horse may become ill from worms.

## **Galusha Farm Horse Herd Parasite Maintenance Protocol**

All new horses to be boarded at Galusha Farm - must be dewormed before going out with the herd, and should be dewormed 7-14 days before arrival, using the below de-wormers as their last application, in accordance with the deworming schedule.

Winter	(Feb 28 <sup>th</sup> +/- 3 days):	Quest Plus - dewormer
Spring	(May 31 <sup>st</sup> +/- 3 days):	Panacur - dewormer
Summer	(August 31 <sup>st</sup> +/- 3 days):	Strongid - dewormer
Fall	(December 1 <sup>st</sup> +/- 3 days):	Ivermectin with Praziquantel - dewormer
